



Scriptures with New Meaning to Begin in September!

It's Almost Peanut Time!!

As in the past, our peanuts shipment will arrive sometime in August. Could you help with the chore of moving the bags of peanuts from truck-side to our storage room off Plymouth



Hall? <u>Watch for signup to help with the Peanuts project</u>. You will be contacted when we know that the peanuts are about to arrive. This is an excellent example of "Many hands make light work!"

Peanuts may be first ordered by members of our church a half-hour before and a half-hour after Worship on August 14 and 21. Orders after those dates are open to the general public in addition to our Congregation.

The cost and weight of a bag of processed peanuts this season will be \$8.00 for 11½ ounces. The bag limit per order is 10 bags. *Orders not picked up after three weeks will be returned to inventory.* Peanuts this season, as last year, will be packaged in zip-lock storage bags, a method that has proved popular with our workers and customers alike!

Peanuts will be available for sale or pickup in Plymouth Hall or the Church Office from 11:00 am to 2:00 pm on Mondays. They will also be available ½ hour before and after Church Service on Sundays. You can also order Peanuts during sale times.

The calendar for processing Peanuts is August 28; September 11, 18, 25; October 9, 16, 23, 30; November 6, 13, 20, 27; December 4, 11, 18; needed dates in January will be determined. If the schools are closed, so are we!!

Everyone is welcome to help make our popular Congregational Peanuts on these Monday mornings. On-the-job training is gladly offered; peelers typically work from 8:00 to 11:00 am. Bring your friends—all are welcome!

As always, **come when you can, leave when you must.** Your willingness to help makes light work for all, but it also makes our Peanut season possible!
