The church **Safety Committee** has been busy meeting during the spring and summer months with the goal of reviewing the **Emergency Procedures Manual** and making updates as needed. This has now been accomplished. The Committee

also reviewed the **Safety Procedures handouts** located in the hymnal holders in each pew. Several changes were made and new handouts distributed. The committee has also arranged for review and/or training for the congregation in conjunction with the handouts, and after much discussion, came up with the following times/dates:

- 1) **Sunday, October 8** after the **10am** service, an Officer from the Fort Atkinson Police Department will give a short presentation on **Unsafe/Armed Intruder**. (Plymouth Hall)
- 2) Sunday, October 15 after the 10am service, we will review Fire / Tornado / Severe Weather /Unsafe Intruder drill (Sanctuary).
- 3) **Saturday, October 21** at **10am**, members of the Fort Atkinson Fire Department EMS will be in Plymouth Hall **to provide training in CPR and the use of an AED**. This will be basic training in CPR and no test or certification will be offered.

There is now a sign-up sheet in narthex for training dates/sessions. All training is provided at no cost.

We hope as many members of the congregation as possible will attend. Thank you!
